Activity 1: FunTakshari: June 27, 2020

- FunTakshari is a combination of Fun + Antakshari to be played on June 27, 2020
- This activity shall be played on Zoom App. Details of which shall be shared with you after you register for the same
- Before you login on Zoom kindly update your screen name with your Name followed by Surname
- Owing to the restrictions of the Virtual platform, limited number of participants shall be allowed to participate and hence entries will be accepted on first come basis
- Its not a team activity and will have to be played individually by the participants
- It will be divided into two segments viz. Preliminary Round and Final round. Preliminary round shall begin at 5:00 PM sharp and final round shall follow immediately after the end of preliminary round
- Only Bollywood Movies are allowed
- Host for the activity is the judge and the decision taken by the judge will be final and cannot be challenged

Preliminary Round

- Preliminary round will consist of 3 rounds of 20 questions each
- Answers to be typed in the chat box
- One needs to give only 1 correct answer out of the 60 questions asked in this round to qualify for the final round
- Once a correct answer has been answered by the participant, he/she cannot answer other question since you have already qualified for the final round, If answered, you shall be disqualified
- 60 participants shall qualify for the final round.

Final Round

- 50+ participants are expected to play who qualify in the preliminary round
- 3 rounds of 15 clues each
- First one to give the correct answer in the correct format will be chosen
- Each answer will be given +10 points, no negative marking
- The person with the highest points at the end of all rounds, will be declared as the winner
- In case there is a tie, we will have 3 tie-breaker questions/clues to determine a clear winner

- This activity shall be played on Zoom App. Details of which shall be shared with you after you register for the same
- Before you login on Zoom kindly update your screen name with your Name followed by Surname
- Owing to the restrictions of the Virtual platform, limited number of participants shall be allowed to participate and hence entries will be accepted on first come basis
- It’s going to be a team game. Teams would be formed on the day of the event randomly
- Each team will be assigned a different break out room where each of the teams can play with their other team members
- A Captain would be assigned for each team. He/ She can share their screen using the “Share Screen” functionality on the Zoom so that all the team members can see the clue together and solve it as a team
- You’ll receive PDF files. Each one contains a question/ clue and is protected by a password
- Answer to the first PDF will unlock the second and in similar fashion, previous questions’ answer will open the next PDF
- Answer in words is not case sensitive and needs to be in small letters only and no spaces required for answers with two words. Similarly answers in numbers to be in digit only
- Only the final completion page screenshot needs to be sent to us on personal chat to confirm the winners

Activity 3:: Kaun Banega Chatur Chanakya :: June 30, 2020

"KAUN BANEGA CHATUR CHANAKYA – Search For Brilliance"

The rules for the contest are listed below:

Eligibility Criteria:

- Any Chartered Accountant enrolled with ICAI as its member and has his registered address in the Western India Regional Council (WIRC) viz in the states of Maharashtra, Gujarat & Goa.
- Active membership number is mandatory for registration.

Disclaimer:

- Connectivity issues and network problem will not be entertained once the rounds get started. The contestants should ensure good internet connectivity. WIRC will not be responsible in any manner whatsoever if the contestant is not able to participate due to network issues.
- The decision of WIRC will be final and binding on all contestants.
- Members of the organizing committee to the quiz are not allowed to participate in the contest.

General Rules:

- All the contestants have to keep themselves on Mute once they join the zoom meeting.
- The questions will be in the form of Multiple choice questions (MCQs) and 4 options will be given to each question.

Registration:

- Registrations for the contest will start on 28th June 2020 and will be accepted till 11.59 pm on 30th June 2020.
- Members can register themselves by filling a form on survey monkey. Link of which shall be conveyed by WIRC.
- 3 questions will be asked in the registration round.
- The contestant who gives maximum correct answers in shortest time gets qualified for the next round.
- The qualifying contestant would be eligible to play round 1.

Round 1:

- This round will be played on 2nd July 2020.
- A WhatsApp group will be created with the winners of registration round.
- The timings for the 5 sub rounds for this round are 12 pm, 1 pm, 3 pm, 5 pm & 6 pm.
- At the above giving timings, 5 different google form links will be shared on the WhatsApp group.
- A demo google form link will be posted at 10 am on the same day. The contestant must resolve all the technical glitches or issues in this demo google form.
- Each google form will consist of 3 questions.
- The contestant needs to click the google form link & answer the given questions as early as possible.
- Contestant's Email address is mandatory for answering the questions & it is strongly recommended to use the same email address to avoid confusions later.
- The contestant who gives maximum correct answers in shortest time gets qualified for the next round.
- The results of round 1 will be posted in the WhatsApp group .
- The registration numbers will be verified and if found to be wrong then the contestant will straight away be disqualified from the contest.
- First 250 contestants will be selected from this round and they shall be eligible to qualify for round 2 of KBCC WIRC.

Round 2:

- Round 2 will be played at 3rd July 2020 at 7 pm.
- A Zoom registration link will be sent to all the contestants through email / WhatsApp group.
- Each contestant has to get registered through that link.
- All the contestants should join the zoom meeting at 6.45 pm to avoid any technical issues.
- Any issues like network problem etc. will not be entertained once Round 2 gets started. So, contestants should ensure good network.
- All the contestant have to keep themselves on Mute once they join the zoom meeting.
- Total 20 questions will be shared on the zoom screen one by one using its polling feature.
- The contestants will have to click on the correct option to the MCQ and click on submit.
- Time allowed for each question will be 1 minute.
- The contestant who gives maximum correct answers in shortest time gets qualified for the next round.
- The results of round 2 will be posted in the WhatsApp group .

- First 50 contestants will be selected from this round and will be qualify for round 3.

Round 3:

- This round will be played online on Zoom on 4th July 2020 at 7 pm.
- Contestants should join the meeting at 6.45 pm for resolving the technical issues, if any.
- 10 Rooms will be created with 5 contestants in each room and the sub rounds mentioned below will be played in each individual room simultaneously.
- The host will add the contestants in respective rooms (members will be informed about this at the beginning of the round).
- Round 3 will be of total 3 sub-rounds.
- **a) Rapid fire Round:**
 - Each contestant will have to answer 5 questions in a given time of total 4 minutes.
 - The contestant can skip the question if he/she is unable to answer.
 - Question once skipped cannot be answered again.
 - For each right answer, the contestant will be awarded with 10 marks. No negative marking for wrong answer.
 - Negative 5 marks will be given to the contestant for any disturbance caused by him/her during the rapid fire round of other contestant and the other sub-rounds. If same behaviour is repeated the contestants will be disqualified from the contest. WIRC reserves the right to take the decision for the same.
- **b) Passing Round:**
 - Each contestant will be asked 2 questions. Contestants has to answer each question within 1 minute or can pass it to the next contestants.
 - If the question is not answered within 1 minute then the question will automatically be passed to the next contestant.
 - Once question is passed, the other contestant will have only 30 seconds to answer question. The next contestant can either answer or pass the question. If not answered within 30 seconds then question is automatically passed to the next further contestant.
 - If the question is answered by the contestant without passing it to the other contestant, every correct answer will get 10 marks whereas wrong answer will get negative 5 marks.
 - *(If question gets passed for the 1st time and correct answer will get 8 marks whereas wrong answer will get negative 5 marks. If question gets passed for the 2nd time and correct answer will get 6 marks whereas wrong answer will get negative 5 marks. If question gets passed for the 4th time and correct answer will get 4 marks whereas wrong answer will get negative 5*

marks. If question gets passed for the 5th time and correct answer will get 2 marks whereas wrong answer will get negative 5 marks.)

➤ For Example:

There are 5 contestants

A , B , C , D , E

1st question is asked to 'A'

If A answers correctly then he gets 10 marks and the question ends there.

If A answers wrongly then he gets negative 5 marks and question ends there.

If A does not answer in 1 minute or passes the question then B gets the opportunity to answer.

If B answers the question correctly then he gets 8 marks.

If B gives wrong answer then he gets negative 5 marks.

If B does not answer in 30 seconds or passes the question then C gets opportunity.

If C answers correctly then he gets 6 marks.

If C answers wrong then he gets negative 5 marks.

If C does not answer in 30 seconds or passes the question then D gets the opportunity and so on the last person E will get opportunity.

If E answers correctly then he gets 2 marks.

But If E answers wrongly then he gets negative 5 marks.

If E does not answer in 30 seconds or passes the question then question ends there.

• **c) Buzzer Round :**

- Total 5 questions will be asked in this sub round.
- The first contestant who types "Me" in the chat box of zoom app will get the preference to answer. Preference to be decided as per the messages received in the chat box appearing on the zoom screen of the host.
- If the contestant answers correctly then he/she gets 20 marks.
- If the contestant answers wrong then negative 10 marks will be given.
- Once getting selected by the host for answering, the time limit for answering the question will be 10 seconds.
- If the question is not answered within 10 seconds by the contestant negative 10 marks will be given and the question gets passed to the second person who typed "Me" in the chat box.
- For the right answer, the second contestant will get 20 marks & negative 10 marks will be given for the wrong answer.
- There will not be any further passing and the questions ends.

- Selection will be done on the basis of maximum marks scored by the contestant in all the three sub-rounds together.
- First 10 contestants will be selected from this round and will qualify to the final round.
- In case of tie, WIRC may take additional tie breaker round for only for those contestants.

4th Round or Final Round:

- This round will be played on 6th July 2020 at 7 pm.
- The rules of final round will be conveyed to the contestants on 5th July 2020.
